InScenio Fm Master 3

Intended use

InScenio FM-Master 1-3, in the following termed "unit", may only be used as a power supply distributor for correspondingly suitable Oase products. The unit can be used at ambient temperatures of -20 °C to +45 °C.

Only connect such other devices and systems to the unit, which will not pose any danger to persons or assets in the event of a malfunction of the transmitter or receiver or where such risk is eliminated by other safety measures. Devices and systems bearing an increased risk of accident must not be activated or deactivated by means of the man-

ual transmitter.

Installation

How to install the unit:

- Remove the protection hood from the unit.
- Set-up the unit horizontally and water-protected, at a dry location, at least 2 m from the edge of the pond (B, C).
- Fully insert the ground stake (3) into the soil.
- Place the unit onto the ground stake (insert the ground stake in a corresponding mounting).
- · Check its stability.

Electrical installation

This is how to connect the power supply:

• Push the female connector of the power supply (6) onto the unit plug (7). The connection is made on the unit rear (D).

Commissioning/start-up



WARNING

Possible death or severe injury from hazardous electrical voltage!

- Prior to reaching into the water, isolate (switch off and disconnect) all units/devices used in the water.
- Isolate the device (disconnect from the power supply) before carrying out any work on it.

Teach-in manual transmitter

Check the function of the manual transmitter by actuating one of its buttons. The LED of the manual transmitter must light up. A maximum of 10 transmitters can be taught in. Depending on the terrain, the range is up to 80 m. When the transmission power fades, replace the battery of the manual transmitter.

Prior to being able to start up the unit, harmonise the manual transmitter transmit signal with the receiver in the unit. For this purpose, the receiver is equipped with a teach-in key.

How to teach-in the manual transmitter (D):

- Insert the teach-in pin (5) into the opening (8) until you feel a resistance. At this point you have reached the teach-in key
- Briefly press the teach-in key using the teach-in pin.
- Keep any button of the manual transmitter pressed for at least 3 sec.

This completes the teaching in of the receiver to the manual transmitter.

Deleting saved manual transmitters

How to delete the manual transmitters from the unit:


• Keep the teach-in key of the unit pressed for at least 5 sec. using the teach-in pin (5). All saved manual transmitters are deleted.

Connect the units to the power supply distributor

This is how to connect your OASE unit to the power supply distributor:

- If necessary, remove the protection hood from the power supply distributor.
- Select a suitable socket from the following table.
- Make sure that your OASE unit may be connected to this socket. For this purpose, consult the instructions of use of the unit you wish to connect.
 - The following is to be taken into consideration: Units powered via a transformer may not be connected to a socket with dimmer function.
- · Connect the unit.
- Always use the pull relief (E, 9) provided on the unit for the connection cables.
- Refit the protection hood to the unit.

Supplemental instructions for operation

- After a power outage the power outlets are switched off.
- Do not connect any InScenio controllers or portable multiple sockets to the unit.
- The device is only de-energised when the plug of the mains supply cable is unplugged.

Maintenance and cleaning



WARNING

Cleaning the device

Clean the unit with a soft, clean and dry cloth. Never use aggressive cleaning agents or chemical solutions. These can attach the housing surface or impair the function.

Replacing the fuse (only InScenio FM-Master 3)

The dimmer is protected by a fine-wire fuse.

Please contact your specialist dealer if you do not wish to undertake the replacement yourself.

How to replace the fuse:

- Pull the plugs of all units connected to power supply distributors.
- Isolate the power supply distributor.
- Hold the unit, then turn the fuse holder counter-clockwise by a quarter of a turn using a screw driver and exerting light pressure (bayonet closure).
- Remove the fuse holder including fuse.
- · Replace the fuse.

Use fine fuse 5 × 20 mm, 2 A slow-blow.

- · Turn in the fuse holder again.
- · Reconnect the unit.

Changing the battery

How to replace the battery in the manual transmitter:

- At the manual transmitter (G, 4) push back the bottom section of the cover (13).
- · Replace battery (14).

Use alkaline-manganese battery, type V23 GA (12 V).

- · Close cover.
- Dispose of batteries in an environmentally friendly manner.
